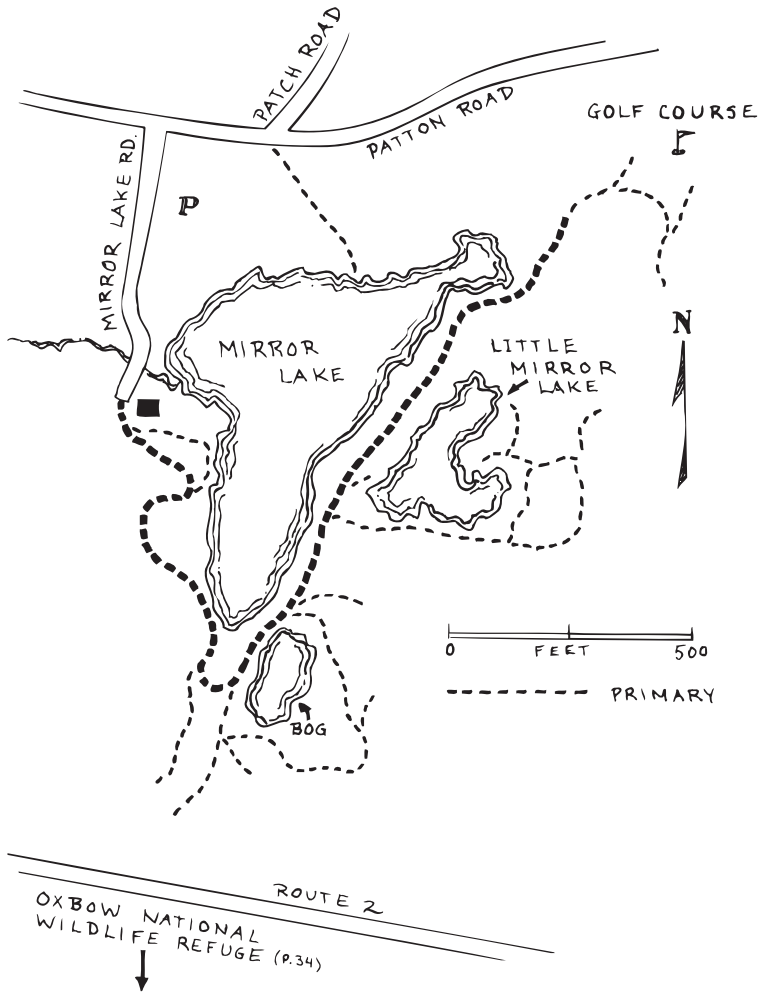


# MIRROR LAKE/DEVENS



Originally known as Hell Pond due to its depth, Mirror Lake was included in the Harvard land taken by the Army to expand Camp Devens in 1917. The trail starts at the beach recreation area, follows around the tip of the lake to a high ridge overlooking a black spruce bog. This bog consists of a vegetative mat surrounded by a moat. The trail continues along the ridge between the lakes and features hemlocks and laurel at the far end. Swimming, fishing, and boating are allowed in season. There is an entrance fee in the summer.
