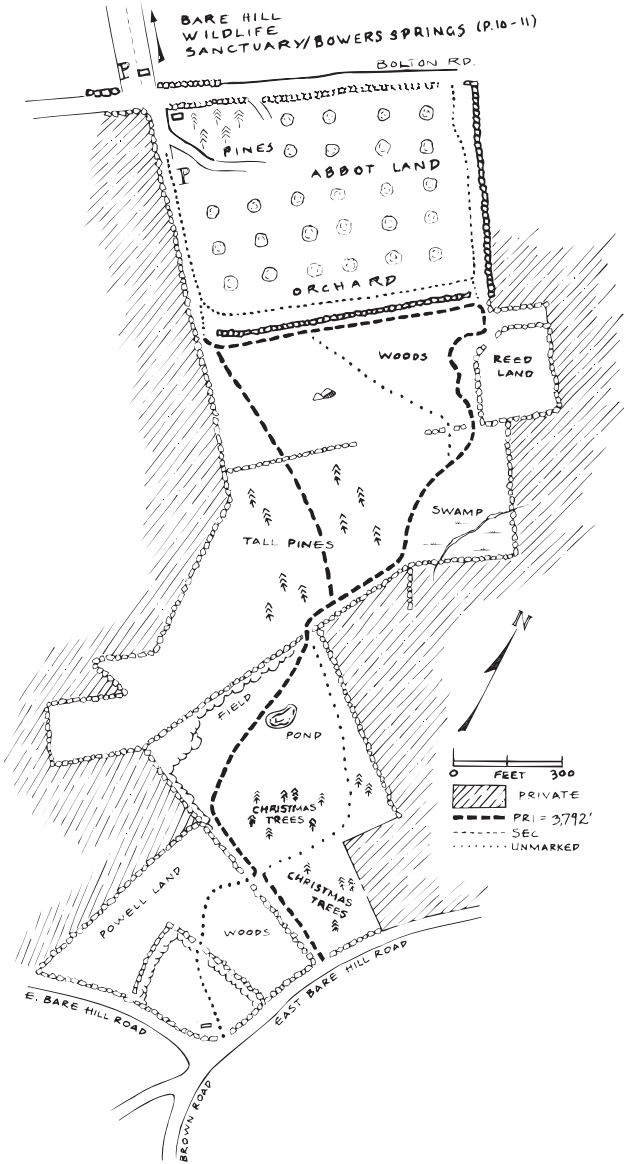


POWELL-REED-ABBOT



The Powell land, acquired in 1975, comprises about 33 acres and is contiguous with the 1.47 acre Reed land and the 10 acre Abbot land. Together, these lands stretch from East Bare Hill Road to Bolton Road, and from here they give access to the Bare Hill Wildlife Sanctuary. The trails are well suited for walking, cross-country skiing and horseback riding. Christmas trees have been planted on the Powell land near East Bare Hill Road. When available, the mature trees are selected and cut by their buyers for the benefit of a Harvard youth organization.
